

Could you be entitled to PENSION CREDIT?

Over a quarter of pensioners eligible for pension credit do not claim it!

£

If you're eligible, you could get an average of £3,300 of extra support per year.

£

Pension Credit is separate from the State Pension, and tops up your income to £182.60 per week if you live alone or £278.70 per week if you have a partner.

£

All you need to apply is your national insurance number, bank details, and information about your savings.

£

You can call 0800 991234 where someone will help you apply, visit [gov.uk/pension-credit/how-to-claim](https://www.gov.uk/pension-credit/how-to-claim), or ask a friend or family member to help you.



Following a successful application for Pension Credit, you may also be eligible for additional support from other benefits including

Housing Benefit and you may be able to access a free TV Licence, Dental Treatment and the Warm Home Discount.

Apply by 18 December 2022 to receive a £324 cost of living payment.
